This is to formally notify the following changes on the RFP V1.0 issued on June X, 2011 for the Optical Scanning Vote Counting System for Puerto Rico

Section	Change
5.3.3	<p>This section shall read:</p> <p>A "Mixto" vote is a vote in which the voter has selected one party by placing a mark below the party's insignia but where the voter has also voted for: specific candidates from other parties, independent candidates, write-in candidates, or candidates from the same party. To be considered a valid "Mixto" vote at least one of the candidates from the party voted under the insignia has to obtain a vote. If no candidate from the party voted under the insignia obtains the vote the ballot will be classified as "PROTESTADA" and no candidate or political party accumulates votes with the ballot.</p>
6.5.1	<p>To clarify that CEE will be responsible of the travel and living expenses of the CEE staff. Any travel or living expenses from Proponent's personnel or representatives will be covered by the Proponent.</p>
6.5.2	<p>Third paragraph of this section should read:</p> <p>A Performance Qualification consisting of at least four mock election events shall be executed by CEE (two for the primaries and two for the General Election). On site technical support from Proponent for these four events shall be required.</p>
6.5.4.1	<p>Second paragraph of this section should read:</p> <p>These requirements shall take into consideration that approximately 5,500 colleges in about 1,600 electoral units will be reporting results within two hours following the end of the electoral event. Proponents shall note that the electoral event will end simultaneously in all electoral units, and that, as a result, extremely high communications traffic shall be expected.</p>
6.5.5	<p>This requirement is changed to MANDATORY</p>
8.3.3	<p>This requirement is changed to MANDATORY AT FAT</p>
8.4.3	<p>Add the following sentence at the end of the section:</p> <p>The counterfeit recognition measures shall be submitted on a sealed envelope as part of the proposal and these details shall not be public.</p>

8.4.6

This section should read:

The machines shall have the capability of recognizing and tabulating all “protestadas” ballots. The total of “**protestadas**” ballots shall be reported as part of the End Report.

8.7.3	This section should read: The system shall be capable of transmitting the election results using the portable memory modules from the Local Commission Offices as described in section 7.4.1
8.11.1	The second table of environmental parameters shall reference to all the equipment related with the EMS .
